

A Warm Welcome

to the

Antikburg Scharnitz



ca. 1900

In Scharnitz lay the Roman fort *Scarbia*, situated between the Karwendel and Wetterstein mountain ranges.

In early medieval documents, the name *Scharnitz* (*locum Scaraza*) refers to a remote, inhospitable forest between Walchensee, Mittenwald, Klais, and Seefeld in Tyrol, where in 763 a church dedicated to St. Peter was founded under the authority of the Bishopric of Freising. However, this church is identified with the monastery of Scharnitz in Klais, north of Mittenwald.

In the Middle Ages, Scharnitz was an important gateway into Tyrol along the trade route from Venice to Augsburg.

Originally belonging to the County of Werdenfels (the border with the County of Tyrol lay at Schlossberg Castle north of

Seefeld), Tyrol's long-term goal was to shift the border toward the strategically important Scharnitz Pass (*Scharnitzer Klause*).

A partial success was achieved when, on 20 October 1500, Emperor Maximilian and Prince-Bishop Philip of Freising ratified a treaty concluded the previous year, which moved the Tyrolean border to within one kilometer south of the village.

In 1633, Tyrol received the right to build the valley barrier *Porta Claudia* at the Scharnitz Pass on Werdenfels territory, to protect against advancing Swedish troops during the Thirty Years' War. It was named after the former Tyrolean sovereign and builder Claudia de' Medici. Remains of the structure can still be visited today.

The building known locally as the "Alte Burg" ("Old Castle") was once a manor house and later served as the former arsenal and command headquarters of the Porta Claudia fortress.

However, the walls—up to 2.50 meters thick—suggest that the origins of the building go back much further and that it was integrated into the fortification.

Through a treaty dated 29 October 1656, Scharnitz and the area around the Porta Claudia were exchanged for a strip of

land around the Kienleitenkopf with the Karlingerhof (Schönwieshof east of Scharnitz) and rights of way into the Hinterau Valley.

In 1670, the fortress was expanded, and in 1703, during the Bavarian Rummel, it was occupied, partially destroyed, and subsequently rebuilt and enlarged.

With the treaty of 28 May 1766, the affiliation of Scharnitz and the Porta Claudia with Tyrol was confirmed, along with an additional strip of land “at a musket shot’s distance from all current fortification works toward Mittenwald.”

Goethe described the border and the Porta Claudia in his 1786 travel report to Italy as “closed by a rampart that locks the valley and connects to the mountains.”

In 1805, during Napoleon’s campaign against Austria, the fortification was besieged by French troops under Marshal Michel Ney. Guided by locals from Mittenwald (Bavaria sided with Napoleon), the French were able to bypass the fortification via a path leading along the side of the Grünkopf and attack the Austrians from the rear. As a result, the fortress was taken.

This path has since been called the *Franzosensteig* (“Frenchmen’s Trail”) and appears under this name in modern hiking maps.
